5.	Reports from HTC's <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Group reviewed reports submitted by HTC's. 	
6.	Use of Great North Care Record for Transfusion Alerts and Special Requirements <p>Northumbria have been discussing the feasibility of this locally to assist the clinical teams in identifying patients who require irradiated blood or who have antibodies (that may no longer be detectable) and potentially have transfusion records held at another Trust within the region. The Regional LIMS project will ensure that laboratories have access to this data at some point in the future – but if held within HIE it would be accessible to the clinical teams. It has proposed that it might be possible to use the Problems and Issues (=PMH) or the Medications page. The Problems and Issues page uses SNOMED coding, so the GP would need to add the alert. By using the relevant SNOMED code for the record this would ensure uniformly across care settings. In order for this process to be beneficial it would need buy in from all Trusts across the region (as well as primary care) and it maybe that the upfront work required exceeds the benefits but would be useful to have a regional viewpoint.</p> <p>Group felt there may be some insurmountable hurdles to this but will feed back any views / ideas to karen.ward@nhct.nhs.uk</p>	All

Key points included:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discussion re use of O D pos in HEMS, feedback from BOBs invited from NUTH and STFT • Convalescent plasma • RECOVERY and REMAP-CAP trials are still analysing whether plasma could benefit subgroups of patients, such as people with low natural antibody levels. • Collecting plasma now to ensure there is a supply available should there be proven benefit in hospitalised subgroups or when used before hospitalisation. • Discussions re: stock sharing. As this is a frozen product, NHSBT would need to supply boxes and dry ice, costs may also be an issue • Transfer of blood with patient: The region recently updated the policy • Demonstration of the Blood Assist App • Transport review ongoing, no timeline • Hemoglobinopathy registry data base in development. Labs to enter anti body status once live. KW to confirm if a secure link will be shared. • South Tees have increasing amount of sickle cell patients.
