#### **12.1 Transfusion Practitioners Group**

Preliminary meeting held to look at way forward, communication to be circulated in next few weeks.

### 12.2 Newcastle Blood Centre Users Group

Meeting held via TEAMS on 6th October 2021

- Interesting update on Electronic Data Interchange with NHSBT given by Gary Cavanagh. Now we just need to wait for the Unified Test List to include Blood Transfusion.
- Following updates from NHSBT the remainder of the meeting focused on updates from hospitals and how we support each other through a number of issues not least the national tube crisis. For the first time ever, the meeting finished ahead of schedule as everyone seems to be suffering from virtual meeting fatigue and are keen to get together face-to-face.
- Staff retention and training remains a big concern.
- The key issue from the region to be raised at the next NBTC TLMs meeting is related to the use of EDN. As part of our highlight reports we looked at the use of EDN across the region and were keen to understand benefits and obstacles. It would be useful to know NHSBT position on use of EDN and VMI and what the plans are moving forward. Some Trust have issues with implementation due to security concerns involving the use of FTP.

## 12.3 NBTC Laboratory Managers Group

- Update on national project 'Use of O D Pos to adult males in trauma and HEMS'.
   Region is compliant.
- · Stocking of AB red cells
  - Discussed with BSMS and NHSBT with a view to developing national guidance
- · Update from Chris Philips:
  - Reminder that stock levels remain vulnerable and are being monitored closely.
- · Fuel crisis:
  - NHSBT is a priority customer and have been assured that they will not be affected by shortages
- Update from Mark Williams re SPICE:
   Working to resolve issues around the system being able to run on the 'Edge' platform. Most functionality does work but issues around opening pdf documents.
- Update from Julie Staves
   NHSi networks are developing basic standards for networks re: Transfusion
   Requirements. Summary of guidance aimed at higher level pathology managers as
   they do not have a transfusion background.

   Aim is to have guidance out by end of the year.
