11.1 Transfusion Practitioners Group

Meeting held 5th November 2020 sponsored by Pharmacosmos, key points included:

- Non-Medical Authorisation of Blood Components. South Tees Trust hosted courses with applicants from Sunderland and Newcastle Trusts attending.

11.2 Newcastle Blood Centre Users Group

Meeting held 12th February 2020 sponsored by Sarstedt, key points included:

- Meeting opened with session with Helen Briggs to review comments raised on the regional LIMS specification.
- Presentation from Victoria Tuckley on the 2018 SHOT report which provoked an interesting discussion on how far we should go to check patient's previous history.
- Joint presentation by Alex Hogan from RCI and Gemma Smithson from NUTH on the Integrated Transfusion Diagnostics pilot that is due to start imminently.
- Sarstedt transfusion products.

Key issues from the business part of the meeting included:

- Agreement on emergency O Neg specification
- Removal of faxes are our plans robust enough?
- Plans to develop a regional concessionary release protocol

11.3 NBTC Laboratory Managers Group

- O Neg Usage Group 4 representatives have joined first meeting next month.
- NHSBT looking internally again at return of O D Neg.
- Concern re UKAS inspections and variability of dates between inspections
- Leeds have been awarded monies to introduce vein to vein traceability, including sampling, supported by MHRA comments.
- Seeking clarification from CSL re comment about storage of Rhophylac continuously at 2-8°C including transportation.
- Virtual blood centre tour launching soon.
- Withdrawal of faxes to be discussed in more detail at F2F meeting in March
- Still working through competency document for TLM and senior staff.
- National 'Transfer of Blood' policy has been reviewed.
- OBOS age of blood box to be removed.
- CQC attending next BCC meeting alignment of accreditation and regulatory requirements.
