#### 11. REPORTS FROM RTC GROUPS

#### 11.1 Transfusion Practitioners Group

Meeting: Virtual 25<sup>th</sup> May 2021. Key points included:

- Discussion around practice, learning from Covid experiences and what is going well
- Education event pushed back to next year. Hopefully face to face.

#### 11.2 Newcastle Blood Centre Users Group

Meeting: Virtual 12<sup>th</sup> May 2021. Key points included:

- Excellent presentation by Alex Liversidge on Gender in Healthcare which prompted a good discussion but left us with more questions than answers as there is a lack of clear national guidance.
- The business part of the meeting then covered the usual updates from NHSBT department and local Trusts with as always, a good debate about incidents that have occurred locally.
- Next meeting is scheduled for September with the hope that face-to-face might be possible.

# 11.3 NBTC Laboratory Managers Group

Meeting: Virtual 17<sup>th</sup> March 2021. Key points included:

- Regional updates limited as progress seems to have been impacted by Covid and virtual meeting fatigue.
- Discussions around blood stocks and the on-going meetings being held to track demand. Again, a plea to ensure any demand changes are highlighted to NHSBT. Early indications are that the NHS Recovery Plans will not impact on blood demand, but a close eye is being kept on the situation. Blood stock position is not good currently (decreased collections and conversion rate in May), not currently impacting on supply but watching closely.
- Work continues on the O D Pos to Adult Male Project. Benchmarking survey has closed and data being analysed. Looking to develop a template to ensure comparing like-with-like when looking at current practices. A toolkit is also being developed. O D Pos to unknown adult males is being added to the existing NHSBT Blood Components App but cannot be included in the BloodAssist App.

#### 11.4 MHRA Blood Consultative Committee

CE noted his concerns on how NHSBT is charging for H&I work.
