- Increase in requests for platelets: Gateshead usage has doubled for haematology patients, South Tees - leukaemia patients increased.
- CVP Retain any plasma you have in stock. Ownership is with the Department of Health and NHSBT is awaiting a decision from them. There is potential for a further clinical trial.
- Plasma for Medicine. Pilot sites for collection in our region is in Stockton.
 The DHSC is responsible for decisions on the future of the programme including funding the possible extension to collection, targets on how much we should collect, and the scale of the donor centre network.
