2019 Activity Summary Report

Education and Training

Regional Transfusion Committee (RTC) Education & Business Meeting 'A Bleeding Nightmare - Improving Patient Outcomes' was held at East Surrey Hospital Post Graduate Centre on 8 March. The theme of the event was managing difficult scenarios

around blood, including massive haemorrhage and struggles with supply and demand. The day included a poster competition to share good practice from around the region, the winning poster was Berkshire Surrey Pathology Services (BSPS) with their entry 'Saving A RhD Negative Platelets'. 87 delegates attended, with 100% of survey respondents saying it was relevant to their educatonal needs, and 85% said they would change aspects of their practice as a result of attending. Overall score 3.7/4.

RTC Education and Business Meeting 'Making a NICE change... in Transfusion' was held at Maidstone Academic Centre on 4 October. 74 delegates and presenters gathered to learn more about the O Neg Challenge, Diagnostic Networks, Tranexamic Acid, Consent in Transfusion and Laboratory Empowerment, Communicating Change plus NICE Transfusion past and present. The 'highlight' for many on the day was welcoming back Malcolm Robinson to update the region on the brilliant progress of Harvey's Gang, and a personal story told by Francesca, the first member. Her presentation was described as ... "very moving and insightful"; "..such a brilliant talk.."100% of survey respondents felt that the event was relevant to their educational needs, 76% responded that they were likely to change an aspect of their practice as a result of attending. Overall score 3.7/4.



Regional Audit



NICE Blood Transfusion Quality Standard QS138 The nationally accessible, gap analysis tool developed by the SEC TP group in collaboration with NHS Blood & Transplant continues to be used, with two audit cycles performed in 2019 in May and November. Over 1300 patients have now been audited over 4 Audit cycles, with participation from an impressive 13 SEC sites. Bi-annual regional audits measure compliance to the four high-priority quality statements, with data showing a regional strength in the use of Tranexamic acid for moderate blood loss surgery and re-assessment after red cell transfusion. 2020 will see an increased regional focus on addressing iron deficiency pre-surgery and informed consent in transfusion. Jo Lawrence, Transfusion Practitioner at BSPS and Anwen Davies, Patient Blood Management Practitioner, NHSBT presented the QS138 tool at the 2019 British Society for Blood Transfusion Conference. Patient Blood Management (PBM) Scorecard – A regional scorecard to understand uptake of initiatives was completed for a second year with 11 SEC sites participating. The scorecard highlights practice to encourage sharing of resources and experiences.
