3 Evaluations of 'The Transfusion Factor' Educational Events

JA reviewed the results – really good feedback received from both events. 93% completed forms.

Combined results from both events for the 4 main questions asked, rated as follows:-

- How relevant was this event to your everyday practice?
 - Excellent / Very Good: 98%
- Overall, how would you rate the speakers?
 - Excellent / Very Good: 88%
- Overall, how would you rate the interactive sessions?
 - Excellent / Very Good: 81%
- How would you rate the information & communication prior to the event?
 - Excellent / Very Good: 73%

Suggested repeating event twice yearly in Spring / Autumn. To be aimed at same audience including anyone relatively new to transfusion. Majority of speakers who took part in March have confirmed they will present at future events. Possible dates discussed, September 2012 and March 2013.
