West Nile Virus (WNV)

Applies to the Geographical Disease Risk Index (GDRI).

- Add index item for Palestine Occupied Territories linked to West Bank, Gaza Strip and Palestine Occupied Territories.
- Add Transjordan index item linked to Jordan, which is not currently an area of WNV infection.
- Change the GDRI entries for the following areas:
