Herpes – Ocular

These changes apply to the Deceased Tissue Donor Selection Guidelines

Please make the following changes to the entry:

Including	Simplex & Zoster Infection
Obligatory	Eyes: Must not donate if: Past or active infection in either eye.
Discretionary	Other Tissues: If no active infection or other contraindication, accept.
Reason for Change	To clarify that even if only one eye is affected, donation of both eyes is contraindicated.
Additional Information	Ocular herpes can lead to serious complications in the tissue recipient, e.g. primary graft failure, and this risk must be minimized as far as possible.
