## **Sickle-Cell Trait**

Applies to the Whole Blood and Components Donor Selection Guidelines only

ObligatoryWhole Blood donor:<br/>Not suitable for intra-uterine or neonatal use.DiscretionaryFor adult use only, accept.Additional<br/>InformationThe red blood cells from people with sickle cell trait can be safely transfused<br/>into most adults. They are however not thought to be suitable for intra-uterine<br/>or neonatal use as there is a higher risk of the cells sickling and causing harm<br/>to the baby.Reason for changeTo allow component donors with sickle-cell trait to donate.
