Airport Stopovers

The definition of an Airport Stopover, as approved by The Standing Advisory Committee on Transfusion Transmitted Infections, is:

A transit through an airport during which the traveller has not left the airport.

When the donor's visit has consisted **only** of an airport stopover there is no need to refer to the Geographical Disease Risk Index.

When the donor's visit has consisted **only** of an airport stopover:

- · Coronavirus risk for the location of the airport must be applied
- There is no need to apply other risks identified in the Geographical Disease Risk Index
