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1. Welcome & Housekeeping

2. Minutes of RTC Meeting 15th May 2020

3. NBTC & RTC Chair's Meeting, 28th September 2020

Craig Carroll attended these meetings virtually.

Highlights:-

- PBM toolkit.
- PBM initiatives Hospital Trusts will be required to have documentation evidence that they are supporting.
- NHSBT modelling for demand and supply.
- Strategic Management in Hospital Trusts.
- RTC regions current 10 regions to align to the NHSE 7 regions. There will be no change for the NW region.
- Education proposed plan is to produce an online educational resource of lectures that will be delivered, recorded and stored on a central server. To include key topics for clinicians and scientists in the field of transfusion. Individual regions to provide speakers but events will be available to all regions.
- Revision of MH Guidelines by British Haematology Society.
- Job Description for Transfusion Practitioner's CC/JB to seek further guidance.

4. Regional Data from ICU Patients with COVID-19

Presentation given by Brian Hockley.

Brian fedback the preliminary findings from the "2020 Survey of Blood Product use During COVID-19 Pandemic" covering the period March 2020 to early August 2020 including the responses for the NW RTC.

Excellent response from NW RTC:-

- 750 transfusion events were submitted involving 199 patients
- 330 conducted on wards
- 289 conducted on ITUs
- 117 conducted on patients receiving ECMO
- 24 missing location (gender items etc...)



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Further analysis is required to understand the proportion of COVID-19 patients transfused red cells as a proportion of total COVID-19 admissions. If obtained, then data could support future forecasts for demand in light of the expectation of COVID-19 to be present in communities for some time.

The data on blood use for patients with COVID-19 confirms that their transfusion requirements were small. This low blood use combined with postponement of much elective clinical activity allowed continuation of a sufficient blood supply despite a major reduction in blood donations at the beginning of the COVID pandemic in England.

6. Emergency Platelet Provision Across the North West

JP / RH were asked to look at a scenario if a site didn't hold platelets and needed platelets quicker than NHSBT where able to deliver. What would their contingency be? Questions sent out to region re this, findings were that only a few sites do hold stock platelets, still a significant number of sites in the NW that don't routinely hold platelets.

RH gave an overview of NHSBT emergency delivery service.
