1. Welcome & Housekeeping

Craig Carroll welcomed members to the meeting and thanked everyone for joining.

2. Minutes of RTC Meeting 4th October 2019

3. NBTC & RTC Chair's Meeting, 30th March 2020

Craig Carroll attended these meetings virtually.

This meeting was at the beginning of the coronavirus pandemic and the agenda was completely overtaken by this.

NHSBT / NBTC has already put in a lot of work with regards to planning and the Convalescent Plasma trials that were all ready to go following the government allocation of funds.

Discussed:

- Issue regarding triage process for major haemorrhage if we enter the red zone of emergency blood stocks.
- The amber and red major haemorrhage activation protocols. Documents of which have been sent out to Trusts.
- Strategy processes of the cascade of information and how this was acted upon.

Nothing else of immediate importance was raised / discussed.

4. Convalescent Plasma

Jayne Peters delivered a presentation on Convalescent Plasma. Jayne advised that she is not part of the NHSBT team who are performing the trials. However, can talk through some of the experiences in setting up the trials.

Jayne's presentation covered:-

- What is Convalescent Plasma?
- Is it safe?
- Does it work?
- Current trials



The following comments were raised:-

Why was it decided that it would only be patients admitted to ITU within 48 hours who could be randomised, as a number of patients with a longer stay on the ITU could have potentially benefitted from this treatment

Numerous comments around the laboratories being left out of notification and planning on their sites, many laboratory managers and transfusion practitioners found out they were opening very late in the process.

Action: Feedback to be provided on the above comments from the Convalescent Plasma trials team. **(JP)**

5. Challenges of Blood Supply

Unfortunately, Dean Neill was unable to join the meeting.

Jayne Peters added that blood supply is stable at present. Currently, a team is working to match the current collections and demands. However, there is a concern if NHSBT don't know when Trusts elective surgeries are to re-start. Trusts to feedback any intelligence about what is going on in their Trusts.

6. Blood Conservation Strategies

Prior to the meeting HTC's were asked to feedback on the following questions:-

- 1) Has your Emergency Blood Management policy been reviewed since the COVID-19 outbreak? Are all staff aware of AMBER/RED actions should they occur? Has the NBTC Triage of MH patients during severe blood shortages document been escalated throughout your Trust?
- 2) What impact has there been on pre-op anaemia/ IV iron services? And have any measures been successful in protecting the service?
- 3) Have any additional PBM measures been taken to conserve blood stocks (e.g. ICS, promotion of single unit and review)?
- 4) Has your Trust informed NHSBT of any recovery plans for elective surgery/services which will impact of blood component demand?

Trusts responses were collated and discussed.

7. Regional Blood Stocks Management System Data

Presentation given by Matt Bend from Blood Stocks Management Scheme (BSMS).

Matt highlighted 2 publications that are produced by BSMS:-

- Regional O Neg report produced monthly
- Red cell / platelet / plasma top level snapshot report on issues / wastage produced quarterly
