- Annual study day to be held on 27th June 2016 at Aintree Hospital. Small group scenario training for 36 delegates.

Pre op Anaemia

Presentation by Kate Pendry on behalf of Jaya Ganvir-Roche, Project Manager. Update:-

- Workshops held in November 2015 & March 2016.
- A Toolkit of Resources has been developed which is available on the NHSBT Hospitals & Science Website. Positive reviews both locally and nationally, for the toolkit's usefulness.
- Engaged with Department of Health Blood Analytic Team to support health economic analysis.
- Commissioning:-
 - Have established support and good engagement with the 9 Trusts of GM Alliance.
 - Aim is to devise a standardised approach in anaemia management of orthopedic patients to enable large-scale commissioning & design of anaemia pathways with CCGs.
 - Alliance Members: Salford, Trafford, Stockport, Tameside, Bolton, Central Manchester, Pennine Acute, Wythenshawe, & Wigan.
- New members have been recruited to the group.
- Continued networking to promote the project locally & nationally.
- Continued pathway development & implementation.
- Continued systematic feedback collection & sharing.
- Baseline Audits of current pathways and transfusion rates is underway to develop a uniform approach engaging with primary care.
- Measurement Tool continues to be piloted at UHSM, using lessons learnt to roll-out to other Trusts.
- Further engagement with Primary Care & Commissioners.
