Minutes and Action Log

Minutes from TP Group meeting held on 18^{th} July 2016 were reviewed and accepted as an accurate record.

Actions recorded on action log – circulated with minutes.

Results of Skills questionnaire

At the previous meeting all attendees were asked to complete a skills questionnaire to determine what to include in future TP meetings. Education and presentation styles was popular and the afternoon agenda. TP's also asked for business planning. WMcS suggested

asking a speaker from the business development team at the Royal Marsden to come and present or request a speaker from Goldman's through her brother.

ACTION: Add business planning to next meetings agenda

Article Ideas - discussion

The idea of writing an article for publication is to raise the profile of transfusion practitioners and increase the credibility. There has only been one paper published regarding the role of transfusion practitioners by Kirsty Dalrymple. WMcS suggested that we collate experience and include diversity of background, education and skill mix. NHS England have published the Leading Change, adding value https://www.england.nhs.uk/wp-

content/uploads/2016/05/nursing-framework.pdf which gives 3 key areas; Health and Wellbeing, Care and Quality, Funding and Efficiency which the paper can be based on. WMcS asked the group to spend 15 minutes thinking about ideas and suggestions. Suggestions are summarised below.

- Traceability an example of how TP's are involved in the compliance with regulations.
 EW shared that they use leaflets on the bags during short periods to encourage return
 of traceability slips. DMc stated that they are implementing ward enquiry and scanners
 so units can be fated on the wards. WMcS stated that this was evidence of creative
 problems solving. Electronic Prescribing ensuring that unit numbers are entered to
 increase traceability.
- Major Haemorrhage (MH) policy development, training, evidence of translational research. RP has A3 laminates of the MH policy in all clinical areas. All transfusion practitioners have put together a flow chart. AJ has a haemorrhage pack in labour ward which includes TxA, giving sets etc. MH simulations/drills and tailored education.
- Grant Applications SC has applied for a grant
- Expert Knowledge TP's have a holistic view. Change practice and promote good practice. Efficiency is gained through appropriate use, audit, and alternatives to transfusion.
- Participation in National Groups
- Incident investigation CAPA, training, RCA, SHOT reporting

WMcS will collate information following feedback from rest of the TP group.

JH gave NHSBT update. There was discussion regarding differential pricing of blood components.

Audits / Change in Practice

The NCA audit of Blood use in Haematology has been published. It has been reported that there was uncertainty from one hospital regarding the results received.

MC reported that they had done an audit into the transfer of blood. All units transferred during the audit period were wasted. MC stated that blood was transferred due to lack of confidence and perceived risk,

ACTION: MC to present audit findings and subsequent change in practice at the next meeting.

DM reported that she had done an audit of appropriate use of RBC. The London Clinic has started stem cell transplants on Thalassaemia patients that need to be hyper transfused before transplant. This was not reflected in the Hospital policy which has now been update.

TP Discussion Points

AJ – Asked about collection of blood and if others allow staff collect blood for more than one patient at a time. There was discussion about the risks of this and how to ensure safe blood transfusion.

AOB

JH asked if anyone would be interested in organising a TP education day. It was suggested that the topic should be around clotting. JD, DMc and DM volunteered to help organise the day. The day will be held at NHSBT Tooting in 2017.

Training and Education

The afternoon session was concentrating on presentation and training.

There was discussion regarding a training passport and whether competency can be transferred between hospitals. The idea of a self-declaration or self-certification that staff can sign was discussed. This could be a regional document/form.
