

South West RTC Proposed Survey of Platelet Wastage in Major Haemorrhage

SW RTC MEETING - Nov 2017



Survey of Platelet Wastage in Major Haemorrhage including Obstetric Major Haemorrhage Calls

Reason for survey: Platelets are an essential transfusion component in medical practice. However, they are short-dated, expensive and wastage needs to be kept to a minimum. This is a short questionnaire to identify practice in major haemorrhage across the region with a view to identifying whether practice can be improved.

The SWRTC agreed in May 2017 to undertake a survey of hospitals in the region to (1) assess guidelines/policy and (2) see how many units of platelets were wasted in (a) general major haemorrhage and (b) obstetric major haemorrhage calls.

Major Haemorrhage calls in obstetrics are considered separately as these often have different guidelines within hospitals.
