1. Welcome: NJ welcomed those present.

2. Minutes agreed

3. RTC Business

NJ asked if there was anything from the RTC that needed discussing. **ML** suggested coming together as a region for donor day in future. **DF** asked what happened with the SERV motorbike drivers as they had been put forward for a Queens Award. **KP** advised they are being presented with that a week Saturday. It was suggested they are invited to attend a meeting to discuss their work.

4. Education Events for 2020

Mums, Babies and Blood.

This has been taking place now for 10 years. **DF** suggested running it in a different area of the region. **NJ** said if the material is already in place, it could easily be lifted and delivered elsewhere. It doesn't have to be a large event but smaller events across the region and could be shortened to half a day if needed. **DA / TN** will explore for their regions. **DF** keen to have at Addenbrooke's.

BSMS

Haematology Trainees

Trauma Intermediate Life Support Course
 ML felt this course was very beneficial. It included simulation which made it a fantastic day. Princess Alexandra has had training similar.
