Quorum

Working Arrangements

The RTT will be accountable to the RTC. It will be chaired by the RTC Chair or Deputy. The RTT will be responsible for the day to day management of the RTC and will lead projects as agreed by the RTC. The RTT will develop project groups with other interested parties within the region to progress any agreed RTC projects. The RTT will meet at least twice a year, between RTC meetings. At least one meeting will be face to face.
