#### 4. NHSBT Update

Jo Bark delivered a presentation on "O D Neg Demand and Supply Challenges". Jo discussed the following:-

# Main challenges to supply are:

- Not enough Ro donations to meet increasing demand; need to increase the number of black donors
- Disproportionate demand of universal components, specifically O D neg red cells and A neg platelets
- Increasing demand of O D neg Kell neg

## How can you help?

- Stock management/ usage of O D neg and A D neg platelets
- Work with NHSBT to achieve an appropriate use of O D neg Kell pos red cells
- Be advocates of blood donation within the black community

## 6. Key Highlights from 2018 SHOT Report & UKTLC Survey Report

Presentation given by Shruthi Narayan and Victoria Tuckley.

Key messages from 2018 SHOT report:-

- Rethinking transfusion education, including technology enhanced learning, learning in teams, non-technical skills and human factors awareness.
- Investigating incidents should be thorough, systematic and identify systemic issues.
- Staffing challenges, including staff shortages and skill mix, need to be addressed to improve safety.
- Learning from near missus is vital to prevent future incidents.
- Standard operating procedures need to be simple, clear, easy to follow and explain the rationale for each step – this will engage staff and improve compliance.

Key recommendations from 2018 SHOT report:-

- All NHS organisations must move away from a blame culture and towards a
  just learning culture.
- All clinical and laboratory staff should be encouraged to become familiar with human factors and ergonomics concepts.
- All transfusion decisions must be made after carefully assessing the risks and benefits of transfusion therapy. Collaboration and co-ordination among staff are vital.
