  - Introduction of Consent Leaflet at Liverpool Heart & Chest Hospital **Action:** Leaflet to be shared on the NW TP Google group **(VW)**
- HTC priorities for the coming 6 months
  - TACO: currently working with IT to include TACO checklist when RBC are ordered electronically (Arrowe Park)
  - Audit compliance of bedside checklist stickers (Blackpool Victoria)
  - Revitalise HTC Meetings by making it a drop-in session (Royal Blackburn)
  - Amalgamation of sites / TP Teams (Wythenshawe)
- Progress with PBM initiatives
  - Business case developed for the purchase of electronic PPID system
