Q.11) Please change typo to MCV. If yes, IV iron/blood tx/other –please state details.

Q.12) Please delete.

Q.13) This becomes Q.12). Include surgeon, anaesethists, GP etc.

Q.14) Please add in - routinely how long in uncomplicated patients.

Q.15) In a patient with known or likely ongoing blood loss, (eg. GI cancer) would you give routine iron? If yes, No, N/A. IV Iron?
