	In total, during 2011, 17/19 Trusts represented (one Trust not represented is an indirect customer). No independent hospitals were in attendance.
Does the RTC have a patient representative?	No – there used to be, but she stood down. The RTT are currently looking at recruiting another patient representative.

The RTC Business Meeting was held in November and the main
areas of discussion were:
 Regional TP and TLM reports Audit (Regional and National) O RhD Negative Red Cell Usage Platelet issues BSMS wastage data Regional conferences and education RTC Work Plan and Objectives
The RTT meets at least three times a year (usually via telecon).
The Audit Group met in November 2011 with a new chairperson. Dr Craig Taylor has stepped down as the Audit Group chair and Mike Herbert (Transfusion Laboratory Manager) has now taken over the role.
The Transfusion Practitioner (TP) Group meet 4 times a year.
The Transfusion Laboratory Managers meet 3 times a year.
A regional cell salvage group met 3 times during 2011 – but in future plan to meet 2 times a year.
A sub-group is looking at the content of a West Midlands Deanery On-line Training Package for blood transfusion.
Conferences: The Journey of Blood: Conference organised by the West Midlands Regional TP Group on Thursday 22nd September 2011. Key themes included NHSBT donation, future threats to supply, the laboratory perspective, SHOT, consent and patient information, overview of transfusion alternatives, case studies and appropriate use of blood components. It was attended by 112 delegates, including nursing staff, laboratory staff and midwives.
Transfusion Today: Conference organised by the RTT on Wednesday 23rd November 2011. Key themes included SHOT, NCA, SaBTO Consent for Transfusion, Transfusion Reactions, ITS, Blood Component supply and demand / where does blood go, Guidelines for transfusion. It was attended by 101 delegates including anaesthetists, surgeons, TPs, laboratory staff and a number of colleagues from the military.
The regional cell salvage group reported on a regional cell salvage survey Jan 2012.
There are plans for a follow on audit of cell salvage practice.

Website	The Audit Group reconvened in November 2011 with a new chairperson. Plans for 2012 include: O RhD neg red cell survey (emergency units) Pre-op assessment survey Audit of red blood cell transfusions Home page used for regional news and forthcoming events. Education, business and calendar sections updated as required. Minutes of RTC and RTT published
Planned Activities for next Reporting Period	 RTC Workshop focusing on O RhD neg red cells and platelets - Friday 29th June 2012 – followed by RTC Business Meeting TP conference September 2012 RTC conference and business meeting November 2012 Regional Cell Salvage group meetings May and November Hospital Transfusion Practitioners Meetings – March and December. There will be a National TP Conference June 2012 in Birmingham. Transfusion Laboratory Managers Meetings – March, July and November. Plans for a joint TP and TLM meeting October 2012.
