1. Welcome & Apologies

3. Y&H RTC Budget

3.1 Report and review of commitments (Paper 2)

4. Regional Educational Activities

4.1 Educational Activities

RTC Annual Study Day 30/09/2013 – Massive Haemorrhage

AD has secured a few speakers already for this event and will be contacting a patient representative shortly who was involved in a RTA. Unfortunately YS will be attending the NBTC and RTC Chair's meeting in London on the same day therefore we need another chair. SS kindly agreed to chair on behalf of YS.

We will probably aim to advertise this in June 2013.

Patient Blood Management – 25/04/2013, The Source, Sheffield

There has been a poor uptake in applicants for this event and AD feels that this should be fed back to the DOH for non attendance. YS agreed that this event needs to be pushed at local trusts for better attendance. The delegates really need to be senior staff, not TP's or laboratory managers. There are 60 places available. This is a very good programme and all speakers (some national) have confirmed.

• RTC Ed Forum – 01/05/2013

AD volunteered to present on 'Consent' – what resources are available to support implementation of SABTO's recommendations.

Any further ideas to be put forward. It will be too early for the results from the regional massive haemorrhage audit.

• Future plans

AD/OC met with KG, the newest member of the RTT this month to discuss running ½ day education sessions for GP's focussing on anaemia management. We are hoping to explore this in the next financial year i.e. what do blood results mean and pre-operative anaemia.

KG advised it would be better for us to attend the education sessions they already hold to engage GP's due to their busy workload.

AD asked if we should still go ahead with organising a neonatal / paediatric education event and will contact DG for advice and guidance on the programme and relevant speakers. We have provisionally set a date for April 2014.

4.2 Audit Working Group update

Data collection is ongoing and the criteria has now been changed to 10 units of any *components combined.* It is still early days for any results.

MK asked if we could look at doing an audit on blood usage in the region. One of the NBTC's initiatives was to look at the use of platelets. We need to ask all trusts if they have any action plans regarding the use of platelets and if so, what progress have they made. If possible, we plan to collate all responses and feedback to the NBTC.

5. Blood Conservation Lead

RH advised they have a potential consultant anaesthetist at Barnsley who is interested in becoming a blood conservation lead and would like to know what other regions / hospitals are doing. There is a great variance between regions and hospitals but ideally they need to be either an anaesthetist or surgeon.

MK added the KPI's will be coming out shortly regarding blood conservation leads and YS agreed we could use this as a tool.
