Constraints/concerns	 Work pressure on some of our Consultant members is preventing attendance at RTT meetings whether face to face or teleconference. This is now significantly reducing the effectiveness of the RTT and is putting pressure on those who are attending. Exacerbated by the influx of new members.
Administrative support for the RTC	 Odette Colgrave, RTC administrator has been in post now for 3 years and based at NHSBT Sheffield centre. Odette also covers the East Midlands region working 37 hours per week.
Other issues	 The potential long delay in replacing Derek Norfolk is likely to have a critical effect on the work of the RTC. There is reluctance and lack of enthusiasm among the TLM members to produce a chair for the Leeds TLM group.
